## **Prom:**

This year's junior/senior prom will be held Friday, May 14<sup>th</sup> at the George Washington Hotel in Washington, PA from 7 pm-11 pm. CH students may bring a guest who are in 10<sup>th</sup> grade and no older than 20 years old. Students and guests must follow all CDC and Covid guidelines as well as all Chartiers-Houston school policies. Students bringing a non Chartiers-Houston guest will need to provide their guest's photo ID and return it with the district's prom registration packet, for both CH student and non-CH student.

Prom tickets will go on sale from April 19<sup>th</sup> -April 27<sup>th</sup> in Mrs. Finfrock's room.

**Cost is \$65.00 per person.** Students cannot purchase tickets without a completed prom registration packet.

- Students are not permitted to leave the prom prior to 10:00 pm and will not be permitted to re-enter the prom once they leave.
- All CH students must be in good standing to attend prom.
- A constable on site for the evening.
- All students will have a temperature check upon entering the facility.

## **Senior Picnic/Sundae Bar:**

The senior picnic will be held outdoors, Friday, May 21<sup>st</sup> at the field house from approximately noon until dismissal. Grilled hamburgers and hot dogs will be provided with the Food Prep classes assisting with sides and desserts. The ice cream sundae bar will be served to the seniors, allowing them to build their own delicious sundaes. This is a fun way to enjoy one of the last days of being a CH senior.

- Students will not be permitted to leave the picnic early without permission or written permission turned in to the office the morning of the picnic.

## **Graduation Practice:**

June 1<sup>st</sup> -- Students will arrive at the high school by 8:00 am. Upon arrival, students will meet in the auditorium for a brief meeting and to view the senior video. The senior video will also be available on multiple platforms and information will be provided to you once details are finalized.

After video, students will dress in their cap and gowns and transported to the elementary school for a “senior walk”. This will take place outside of the building and is a special moment for seniors and the elementary staff and students.

Students will return to the high school for graduation practice and will run through graduation procedures both in the auditorium and on the field.

### **Senior Breakfast & Assembly:**

Students will report at 8 am for their Senior Breakfast in the high school cafeteria. Teacher awards will be presented at that time. Students are asked to wear their class colors as their assembly will immediately follow the breakfast.

- A second graduation practice is schedule for June 2<sup>nd</sup> after scheduled activities.

### **Graduation:**

Graduation will be held Friday, June 4<sup>th</sup> in the high school stadium beginning promptly at 7:00 pm. Students will need to arrive at the field house no later than 6:15 pm.

Students will receive tickets in accordance with maximum capacity set by the CDC guidelines. The number of tickets are TBD.
