

Dear Parent and Guardians:

This letter is to inform everyone about the plan to Re-Open the District to a 4 day school week. We have had a successful start to the year given the challenges we all have faced in our return to school. We would like to thank the entire Chartiers-Houston Community for their support during this difficult time.

On October 19, 2020, the Chartiers-Houston School District Board of Directors voted for the administration to start the process for going to a 4 day school week starting November 2, 2020.

The following information will be in place:

Instruction:

- 4 days a week for in-person instruction. (Monday-Tuesday and Thursday –Friday)
- Each Wednesday is online learning for all students
- Students can remain in remote learning full-time. If you choose to stay remote, moving to in school classes will occur only at the end of the second 9 weeks
- If you need to change your educational placement choice prior to November 2, please contact your child’s building office.

Face Covering:

- The Mandate is still in place.
- All students must wear a mask or face shield at all times in the building.
- Students will be given breaks throughout the day.

Transportation:

- Masks must be worn at all times on the bus.
- Students must sit daily in their assigned seats.
- Parent transportation is encouraged if feasible.

Finally, this has been a very challenging time with information changing on a daily basis. To be successful, we will continue to need a team effort to navigate and change our procedures to maintain the health and safety of all our students, staff and community.
