Clarification for School Attendance for Hybrid Learners



Parents/Guardians:

The purpose of this communication is to clarify the attendance expectations for hybrid learning. If a parent/guardian has signed their child up for hybrid learning, the expectation is to have that child attend school, **IN PERSON** on his/her two assigned days, and work remotely on the other 3 days that week. There have been requests made for hybrid students to complete their schoolwork remotely should they be physically absent from school. Of course, if they are well enough, they are able to do this. However, the student will still be marked absent from school. If you provide an excuse, then this will be a legally excused day of absence from school.

If a student does not pass the districts COVID-19 screening he/she is to stay home from school. In this case the student can attend school remotely. However, the family must be in communication with our school nurse, Mrs. Lucas and work with her to identify what needs to be done **prior to the child being allowed to return to school in-person**. If the child remotely attends all classes and does all assignments, then it will not be marked and absence.

If a circumstance necessitates that a student's parent/guardian switches the child's status, this can be done by contacting the school. Notice should be given so that the staff has ample time to prepare for the switch (especially when switching from remote to hybrid). **This request may be denied based on class availability**. While there is not a set amount of time that a student should remain in one type of learning mode, changes should not be made frequently.
