

Important Health Notice from the Chartiers-Houston School District

November 16, 2020

This letter is to notify you that 4 individuals at the Junior /Senior High School has tested positive for COVID-19. Three of the students have not been in the building prior to the positive test. Contact tracing is being conducted for the one individual who was in the building prior to the positive test.

The District has reported this information to Pennsylvania Department of Health. We are working with the Health Department and are taking all recommended steps to ensure the safety of our students and staff. Steps we are implementing in cooperation with the Health Department include:

- The individuals will not return to our school until they have completed isolation procedures for COVID-19.
- The impacted areas of our school will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized.
- Initial contact tracing conducted by district personnel indicated no close contacts (any individual within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) with this individual. In the event that close contacts are identified upon further investigation, those contacts would be called by the District or the Department of Health.

Earlier today, the Department of Health (DOH) confirmed that Washington County has moved from a Moderate Level of community transmission to a [Substantial Level of community transmission](#). Although school mitigation efforts have prevented the spread of disease within our schools, only 8% of cases are 18years of age and below, high levels of disease in our community jeopardizes our ability to continue to safely staff and operate our schools. **Due to this information, the district has changed the JSHS Calendar. Please see below the new calendar.**

We will also continue to update families if any additional steps are required by the Health Department. As a reminder, if your child experiences any COVID-19 symptoms, please contact your medical provider:

The District is closely monitoring this situation and will notify staff and families if any additional actions need to be taken in the near future.
