

Important Health Notice from the Chartiers-Houston School District

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

This letter is to notify you that an individual at the Junior /Senior High School has tested positive for COVID-19. The District has reported this information to Pennsylvania Department of Health. We are working with the Health Department and are taking all recommended steps to ensure the safety of our students and staff. Steps we are implementing in cooperation with the Health Department include:

- The individual will not return to our school until they have completed isolation procedures for COVID-19.
- The impacted areas of our school will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized.
- Initial contact tracing conducted by district personnel indicated no close contacts (any individual within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) with this individual. In the event that close contacts are identified upon further investigation, those contacts would be called by the District and the Department of Health.

We will also continue to update families if any additional steps are required by the Health Department. As a reminder, if your child experiences any COVID-19 symptoms, please contact your medical provider:

In the event that there is a second confirmed case at the High School within the next 14 days, the High School would close for 5-7 days per Health Department guidance. If that would occur, all students at the Junior/Senior High School would attend class remotely during that time period. The District is closely monitoring this situation and will notify staff and families if any additional actions need to be taken in the near future.
